## Grace Point Accommodations:

**Treehouses:** The Treehouses offer bunk-style arrangements, a shared bathroom space, and porches. Each Treehouse has two rooms that sleep 16 people each. Treehouse campers should bring their own sheets and towels, as these are not provided.

**Manley House:** Manley House sleeps 25 people, all bunk beds. It sits at the top of the ridge overlooking Watts Bar Lake and includes a full kitchen, a large screened-in porch, three common areas, a dining room, and a deck overlooking Watts Bar Lake. Campers should bring their own sheets and towels, as these are not provided at Manley House.

**Cottages**: Each cottage features three bedrooms with two queen beds in each, private bathrooms, a kitchenette, and a porch. Each Cottage sleeps up to 12 and will be shared with at least one other families or individuals. Sheets and towels are provided in Cottages.
